
- Curated Collections focus on a theme, grade, topic and include a vetted selection of OER.

Groups provide a space for people to collect, curate, and organize OER.

- Create your own folder structure
- Save resources to your Group
- Work with others to create and suggest new resources for a Group.
- Engage in Discussions with other Group members.

Anyone can look at another Group's collections.

- Get ideas about resources that are in use by others.
- Find resources that are newly added to Groups of interest.






The OERC Toolset: Providers
