


## DEGREE-SEEKING FALL ENROLLMENT TREND BY REGISTRATION STATUS





FALL 2022 ENROLLMENT

BY GENDER




## SYSTEM GRADUATES AND AWARDS BY COLLEGE, ACADEMIC YEAR 2021 - 2022

The Division of Academics, Student Affairs and Research is providing access to the Association for Career and Technical Education (ACTE) online training – *Fully Online Doesn't Mean Inactive*. Over the last several years, the landscape of education has been greatly impacted by the pandemic, changing how colleges provide education through more online teaching opportunities. *Fully Online Doesn't Mean Inactive* includes information on creating an engaging learning experience for online students through understanding active and passive learning. This training is entirely online, self-paced, and takes about 4 hours to complete. It consists of four modules and includes quizzes to test your knowledge as you complete the course. By passing all quizzes, a Certificate of Completion is provided by ACTE.

*Fully Online Doesn't Mean Inactive* is open to SCTCS full-time and adjunct faculty who teach in any career and technical education course. Areas include, but are not limited to, Administrative Technology, Agriculture, Baking and Pastry, Barbering, Building Construction, Computer Technology, Cosmetology, Early Care and Education, Health Science, Human Services, Manufacturing, and Paralegal.

Twenty (20) registrations are available and will be provided on a first-come, first-serve basis. By completing the registration, you are committing to completing the entire program by December 31, 2022 and providing feedback to the System Office after completion. You will receive a confirmation email whether you are selected to participate in this program or not. 
# DUAL ENROLLMENT: HIGHLIGHTS





# TRANSFER: HIGHLIGHTS

*The SC Technical College System offers the most accessible, affordable and relevant pathway to a four-year degree through guaranteed transfer partnerships.*



South Carolina technical colleges are a **destination of choice** for students seeking to earn a bachelor's degree through transfer.



There are **20 systemwide transfer agreements** with 18 institutional partners creating direct pathways to four-year degrees for associate degree graduates from all 16 technical colleges within the System, regardless of geography.



The System supports the legislative proviso that would create guaranteed pathway to all state four-year institutions for Associate in Arts (AA) and Associate in Science (AS) graduates. From the 2021-2022 academic year, that's **2,654 graduates** across the System.



Average annual tuition at a SC technical college is about **36% of the average annual tuition** at a four-year institution.


