- Verify that your microphone is muted until necessary.
- Display your screen name as your **First and Last name**. If necessary, click Participants tab, hover over your name, click **More**, and choose **Rename** to edit.
- Dress in a professional manner that would be appropriate for a face-to-face interview.
- Choose a setting or virtual background that displays as professional an image as possible.
- Eliminate noise to prevent distractions.

Resumes are an important part of the interview process. Because you will be interviewing via Zoom, you will be required to have your resume available on your desktop to share with your interviewer. This will be accomplished by clicking on the green “Share Screen” icon in the Zoom menu.

Understand there is not a specific job for which you are interviewing. This event is for practice, professionalism, networking, and expert feedback.
