EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education has adopted the following criteria for the naming of institutions:

1. The applicant institution must possess substantially all of the characteristics of a two-year higher education institution.
2. The applicant institution must be accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.
3. The area commission of the institution must take prior formal action to approve the submission of an application to the State Board in accordance with the procedures prescribed.
4. The name shall be (descriptor of Service Area) Technical College.
