It shall be the policy of the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education to recognize the designated service areas for each technical college, as delineated in the accompanying table. The Board further holds that all activity in a designated service area which falls within the prescribed mission of the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education as mandated by public law, shall be the responsibility of the respective area commission and technical college.

Established procedures 1-2-101.1 and 1-2-101.2 fully describe cooperative agreements between multiple colleges conducting programs, courses, trainings, and company projects across service areas.

Any technical college that conducts programs, courses, trainings and/or company projects outside their service area and fails to comply with established procedures referenced above will be required to forfeit all revenues associated with the interservice area activity in question.
