DATE OF REVIEW:

The purpose of the Innovative Technical Training Committee is to research and recommend to the Executive Director activities and strategies that enhance the quality and relevance of technical training and instructional programs throughout the South Carolina Technical College System. Committee membership shall include the State Board's Chief Technology Officer, the Associate Executive Directors for Academic Affairs and Technology, Finance, and Economic Development and five technical college presidents appointed by the Executive Director after consultation with the Executive Committee of the Presidents' Council.
