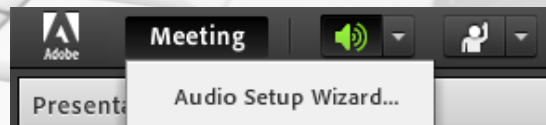

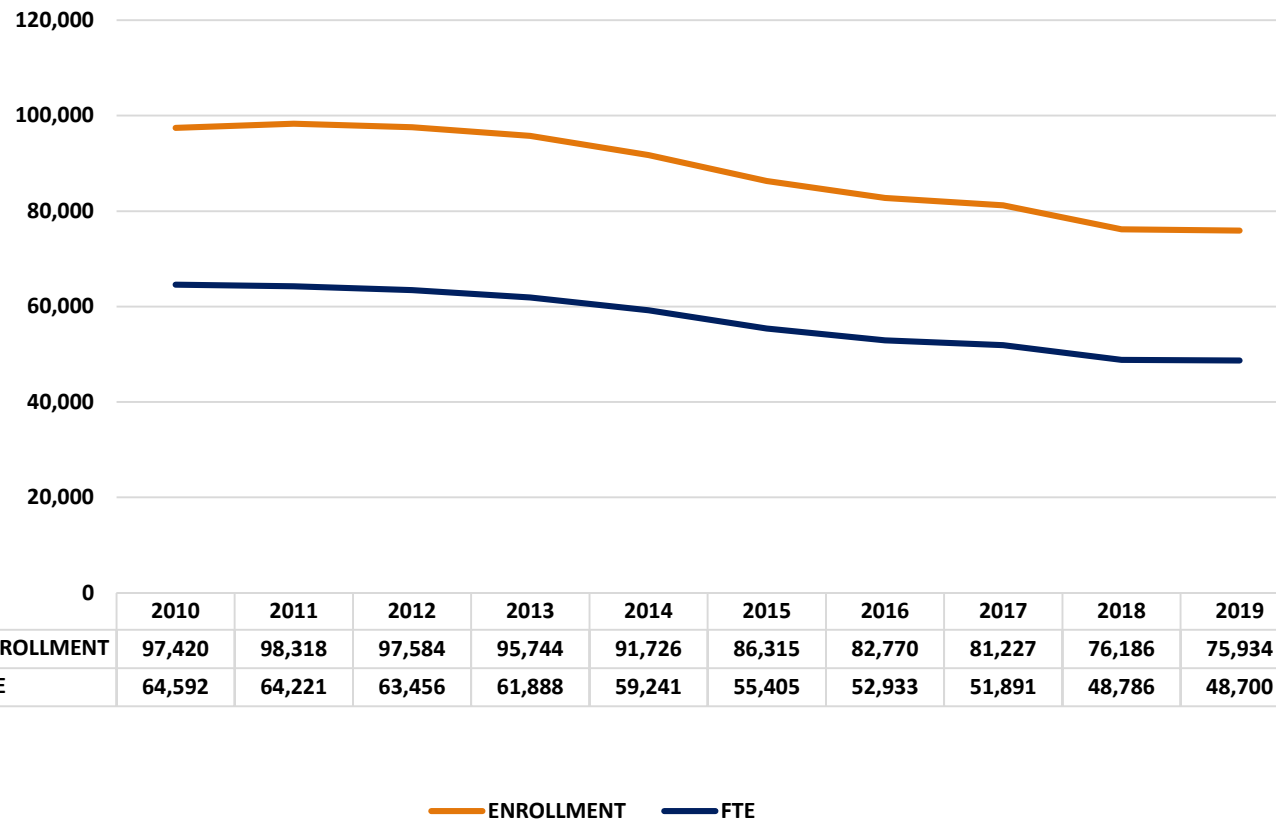

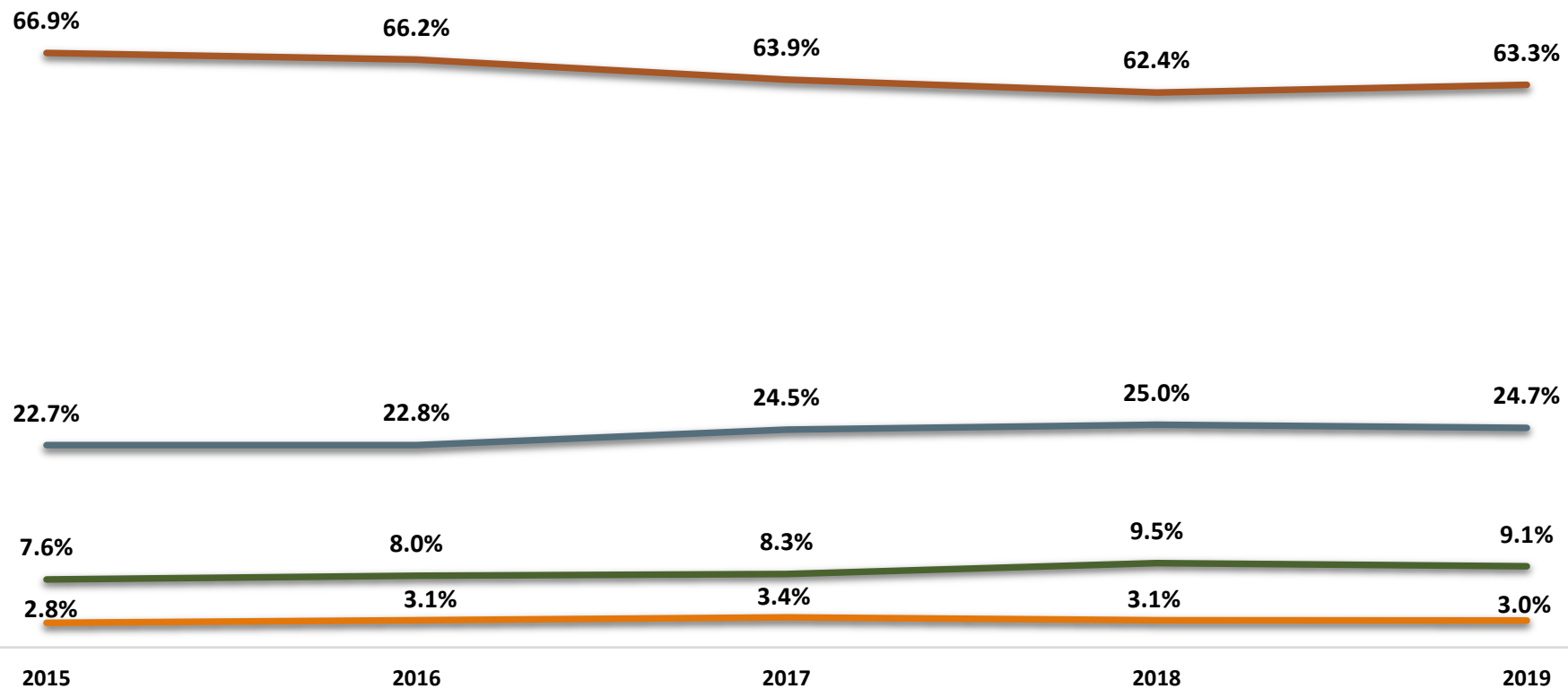

Degree-Seeking Fall Enrollment Trend by Registration Status

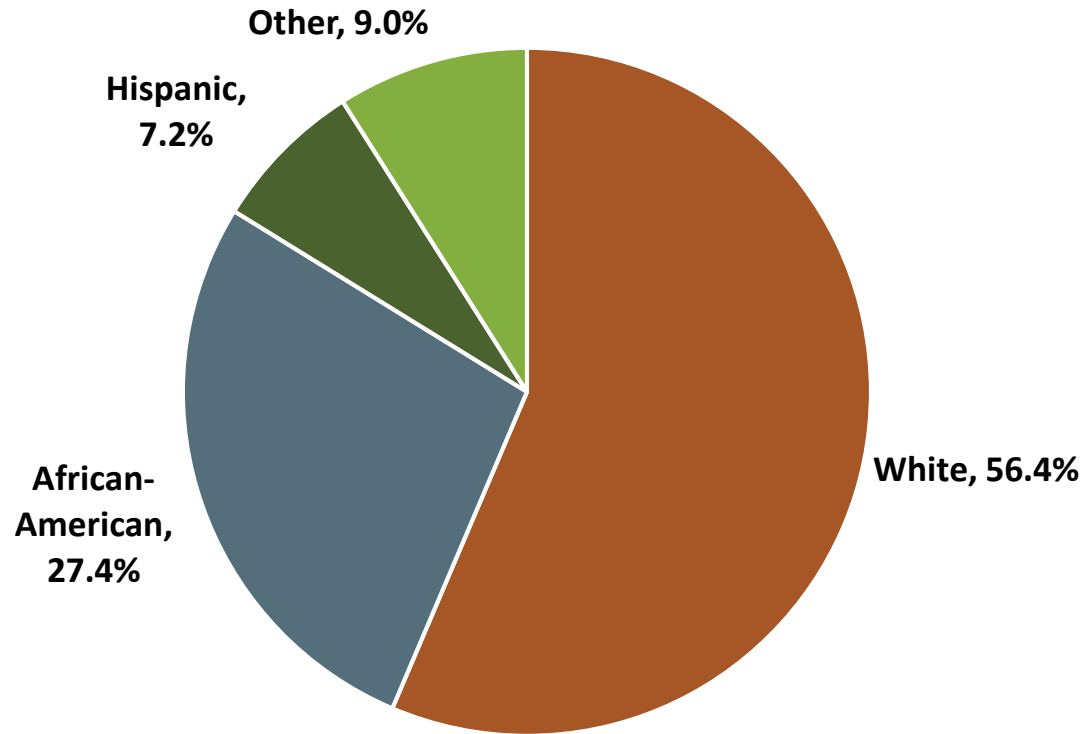


Continuing First-time, Freshman First-time, Transfer Readmit

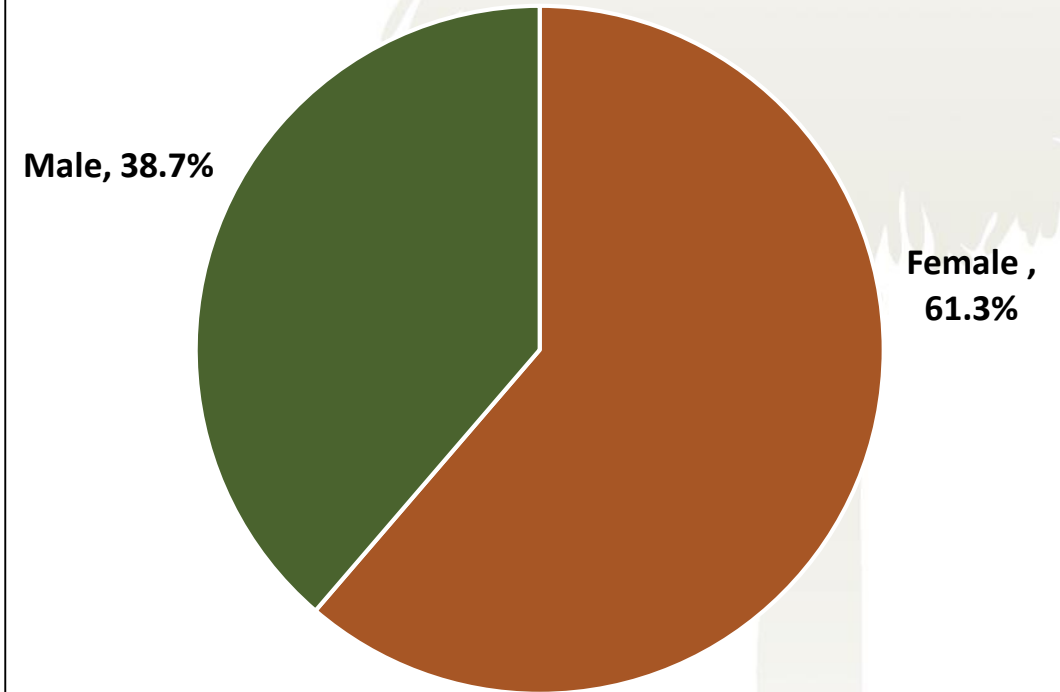

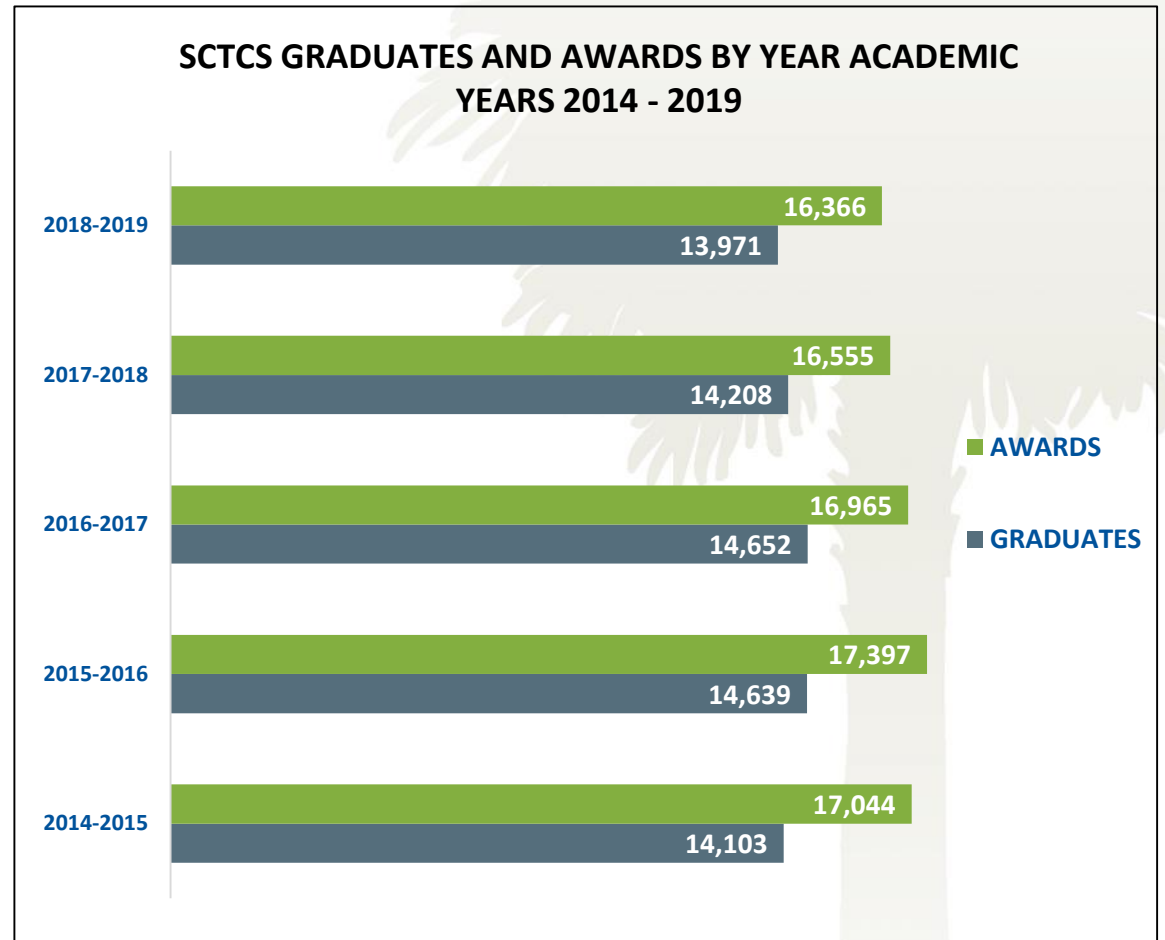
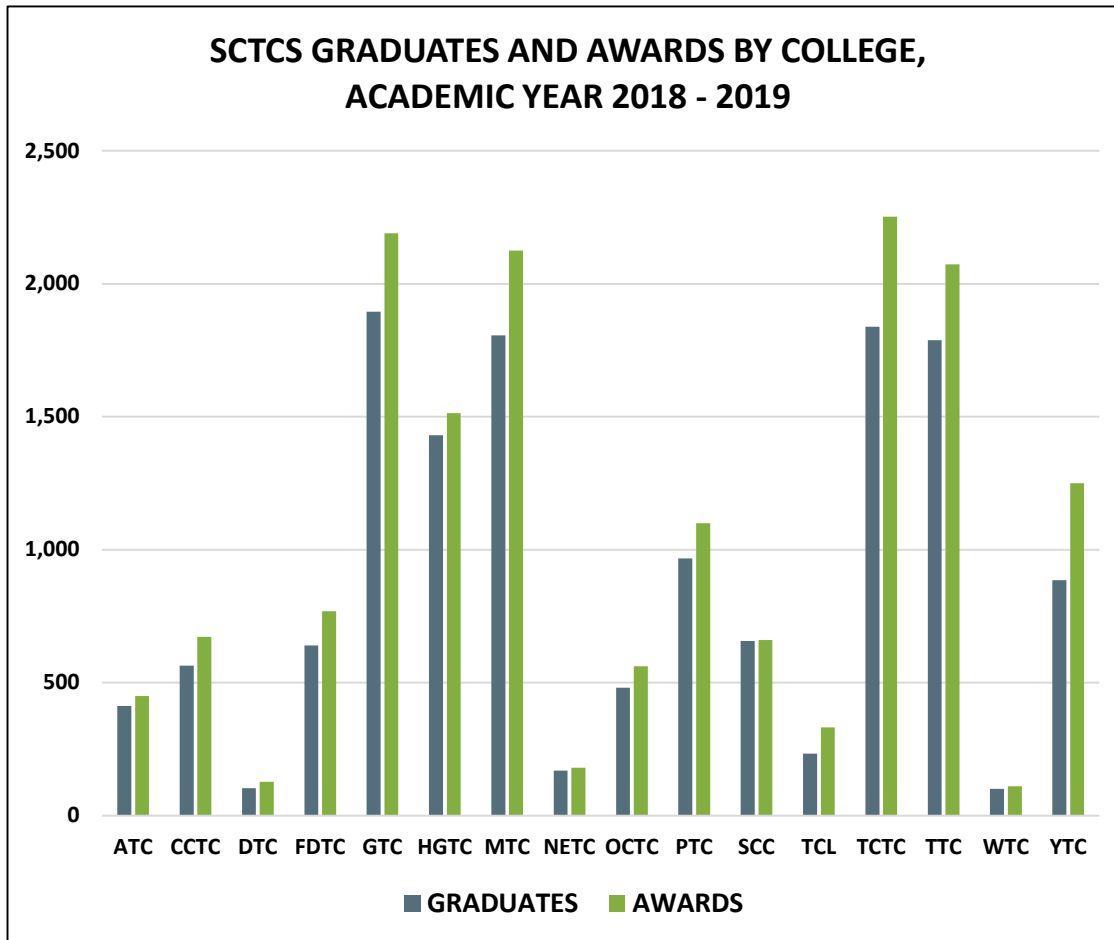
FALL 2019 ENROLLMENT BY RACE/ETHNICITY



FALL 2019 ENROLLMENT BY GENDER

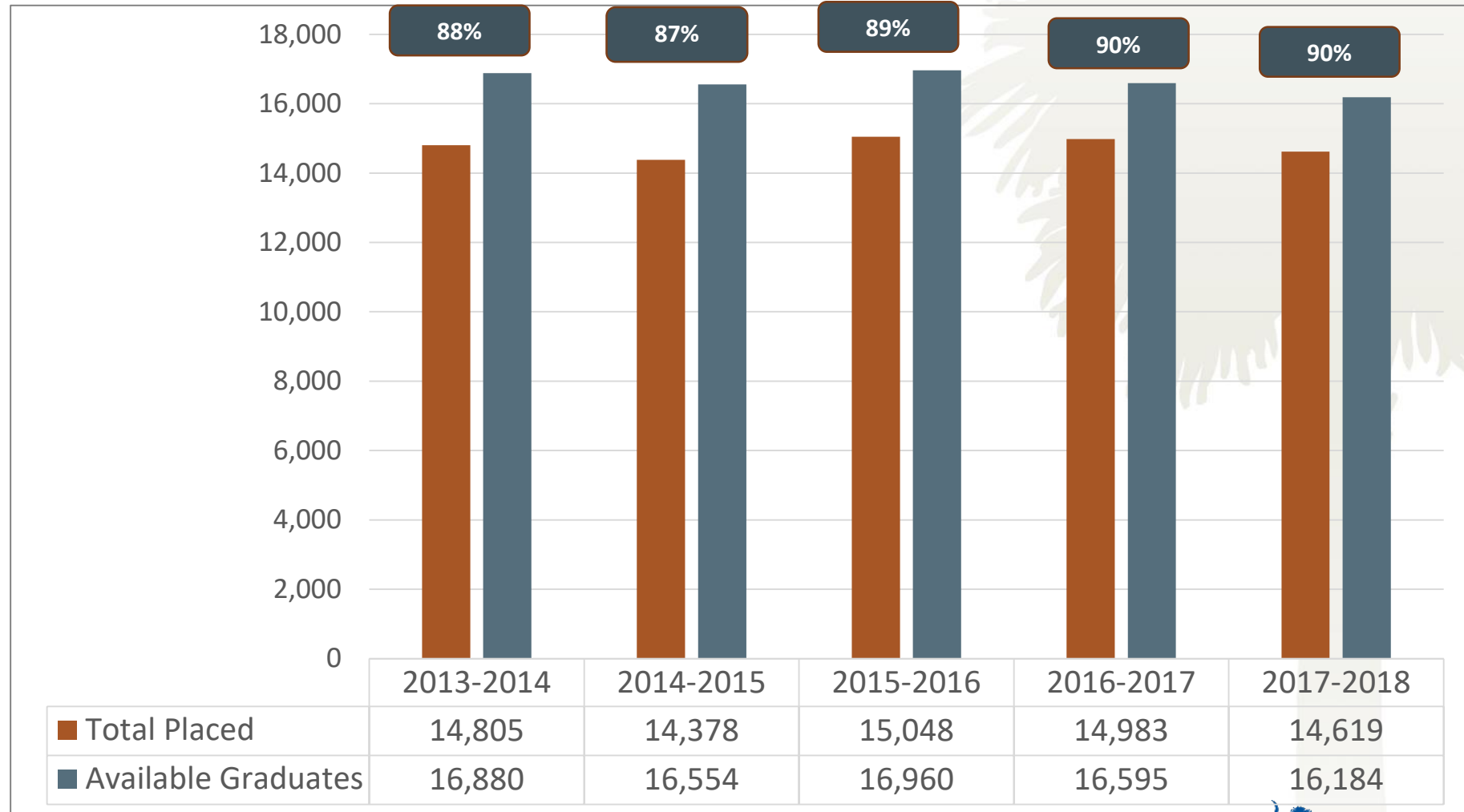

## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

A statewide technical college scholarship program designed to address workforce shortages in South Carolina. It supplements Lottery Tuition Assistance to help cover any tuition and mandatory fees left after applying all other scholarships or grants.



## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

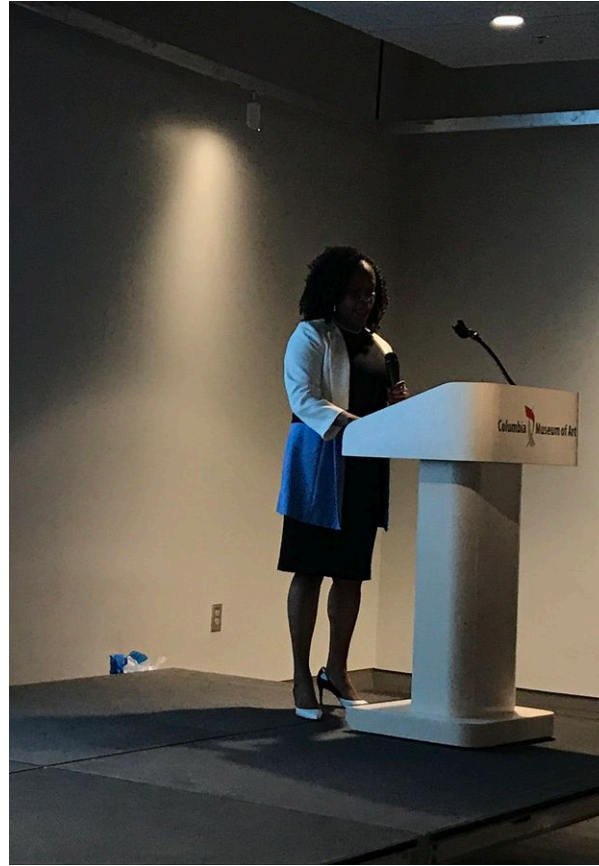
Must be receiving LTA for the current academic year and majoring in a critical workforce area  
**OR**  
Must be receiving LTA for the current academic year and meet the USDA income eligibility guidelines for free and reduced-priced meals.



## COVERED EXPENSES

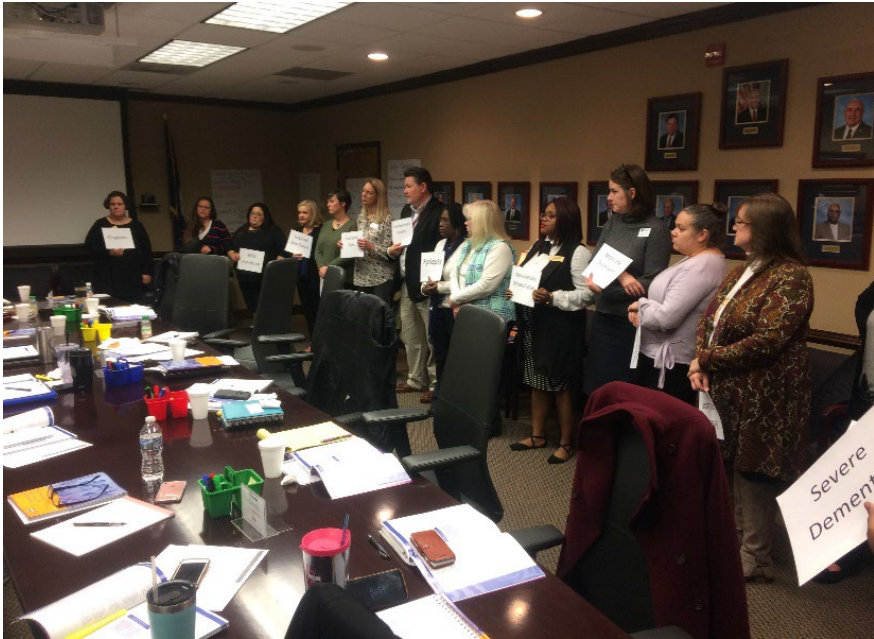
During the Spring 2020 semester, recipients receive \$100 per credit hour up to \$2500 annually after applying all other scholarships or grants. The scholarship may cover the cost of tuition and mandatory fees. There is also a book allowance of up to \$300 per year if a student qualifies through the critical workforce area criteria.





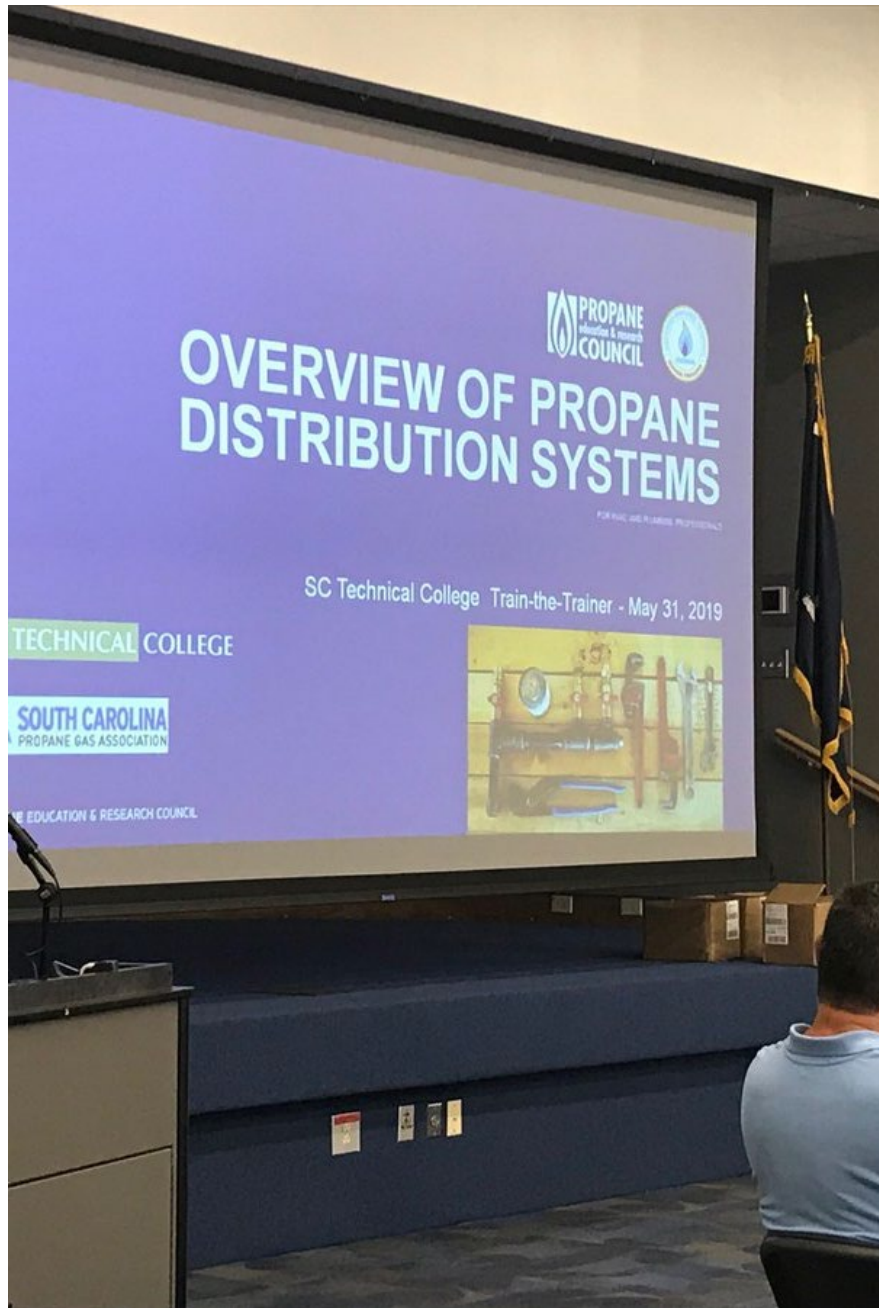

# CURRICULUM REVIEW

- Peer Group Support
  - Early Childhood Development (ECD) – Transition to updated ECD 101 course
  - Library Directors – Transition to updated PASCAL shared services platform

# PERKINS V

- 2019 began the transition to Perkins V legislation
- The technical colleges and secondary institutions are working together to complete a Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment
- Updated performance indicators
- Non-traditional Crosswalk updated
- New Reserve Fund available for eligible technical colleges, focusing on rural areas in South Carolina
- National Alliance for Partnerships in Equity (NAPE) Workshop

# INSTITUTIONAL RESEARCH

- Pre-Gateway Study
  - Intent was to explore the landscape of developmental education in the SCTCS; developed into a pre-gateway study, i.e., sequence of courses before gateway course
  - Presentations made to the Institutional Effectiveness (IE), Developmental Education, and CAO Peer Groups
  - Report is forthcoming

# FEDERAL POLICY RELATED UPDATES

## State Authorization

- Final federal regulations regarding state authorization were released Nov. 2019 with a July 1, 2020 implementation date
- Institutions must choose whether to continue abiding by 2016 state authorization rule and transitioning to new rule by July 1, 2020 OR immediately comply with the new regulation

## Accreditation

- Final federal regulations regarding accreditation were also released Nov. 2019 with a July 1, 2020 implementation date
- The new rule removes the distinction between national and regional accreditation; allows accreditors to more quickly approve institutional changes
- The final regulation also allows accreditors to consider subject matter expertise in lieu of academic preparation for dual enrollment faculty approval

# FEDERAL POLICY RELATED UPDATES

## Title IX

- Draft regulations released November 2018
- Over 124,000 comments received during two-month public comment period
- Final regulations expected Spring 2020???

# COMPLIANCE

- Revisions to SCBTE 3-2-106.2: Procedures for Addressing Allegations of Sexual Violence & Sexual Harassment did not move forward due to lack of final federal Title IX regulations.
- Assisted with revisions to Student Code and Student Grievance Procedures
- Web Accessibility Technical Assistance and SC Department of Education Web Accessibility Training were offered in 2019
- Developing compliance frameworks for various division areas

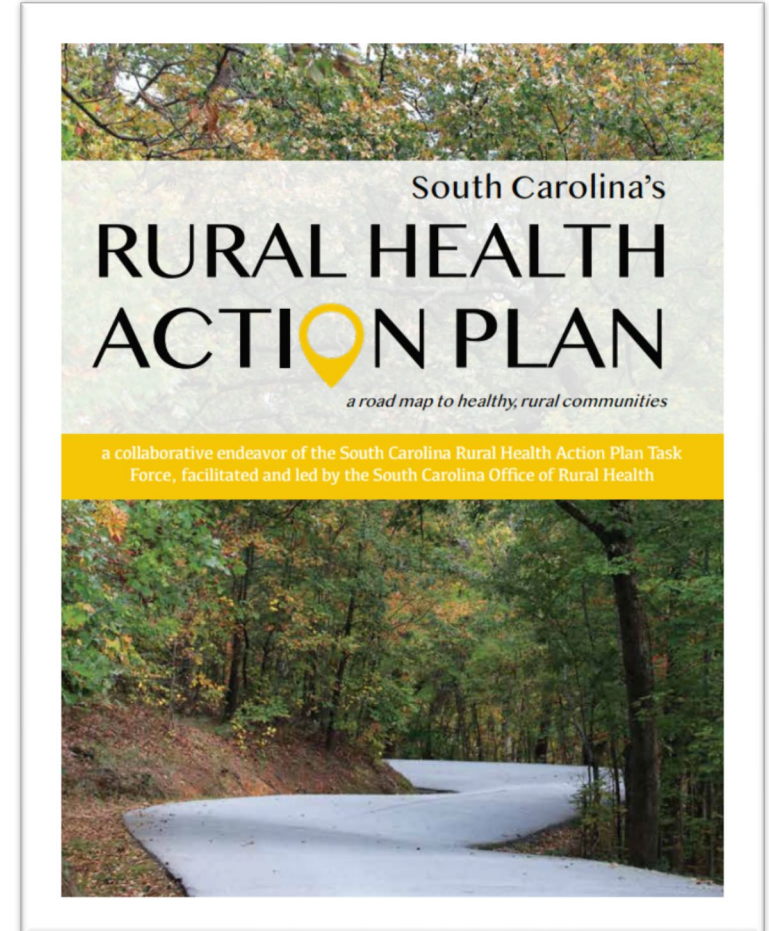
