
## Living Paradox

Transformation challenges us, others, systems, society, material and human, to dare to live dialectically in the tension between self and other, between what is and what might be. Grounded in compassion and diversity, we work together to un-cover (apokalýpto) what is hidden, to contextualize what happens to us, to mediate the dialectic that keeps us on the edge, that may be keeping us alive. Engaging with transformation is always fraught with risks, yet only by daring to see such opening(s) can we hope to transform (self and society) and thrive in an uncertain world.

### Learning at the threshold of ambiguity

"Complexity requires being prepared for learning through: balancing a commitment to unfolding plans and actions while remaining open to the implications and possibilities embedded in the unanticipated consequences that emerge while taking action"

(Nicolaides, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2015, 2020)



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# Growing Beyond Single & Double Loop Learning

Cultivating capacity for response-able learning:

Growing a sensitivity and awareness of our lived experience that corresponds to the values we espouse while attending to the ethics of our individual and collective responsiveness.

Meaning making is generated by confronting the vulnerability in not knowing and the humility of learning to learn from small and continuous inquiry at the threshold of the unknown.





## Creating Conditions to Grow & Develop Learning that is Response-able

#### Mindsets-

Growing the capacity (mindset) to respond to disruptive change, which requires that we learn to shift our awareness from one state to another. Its about suspending our habit of increasing what we know, so that we may also grow how we know.

### Skillsets:

Acquiring skills, tools, and practices that solve problems. Increasing the base (*skillsets*) of our knowledge.




### Vulnerability

Is defined as uncertainty, risk, and emotional exposure. Paradoxically, is the source of mutually transforming power.

Vulnerability is the path to connection.

Connection is the source of transformation.




### Generative Learning

Generative Learning, describes learning that involves a profound shift in mind, embodied vulnerability, and contact with the vast expansiveness of being. Learning to listen to our selves, to understand the language of our bodies, to stay present and connected in relational entanglements, and to allow for the growth of ways of knowing, doing, and being that occur intra-actively with human and more-than-human-encounters.

The effect of generative learning is a change of heart.

The effect of a change of heart is transformation.



### Generative Learning

I define generative knowing as ways of becoming. Becoming denotes the softening to undergoing encounters with the experience of the unknown that are generative. Generative signifies the entangled emergence of insight, trustworthy to guide ethical action(s) that are always entangled with self, collectives, community, society and all that is already interactive.


Ways of being and becoming
